Cancelled 2013 Fall Icicle Pansy installation at 8 Mile because of continued poor performance vis-à-vis deer, rabbits, & road salt; Board decided to
		 cancel at 9-mile as well. Board decided to apply saved pansy funds (\$2537) toward LED Xmas lights in 2014 Road Commission of Oakland County (RCOC) confirmed County ownership and primary maintenance responsibility for Brickscape Drive from 8-mile to, and slightly around, the curve into Begonia Brothers' yards. Novi Department of Public Services (DPS) confirmed DPS primary maintenance responsibility for Brickscape Walkway. Drafted letters for RCOC and DPS upgrade/approval and emailed approved letters to affected Ashbury residents whose homes border that walkway. Novi Forestry Department reviewed the two topped tree trunks and the seven tree stumps along 9-Mile Entryway between curb and sidewalk. They volunteered to remove those trunks and stumps as soon as the ground is frozen and then to plant two new trees in the spring west of Chase Drive where there are no overhead utility lines. Applied Science, Inc. contacted us. They are a Consulting Engineering firm retained by Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner to make repairs to a manhole, drain channel, and surrounding area near a county branch of the Rouge River, which is landlocked between Chase Farms and Riverbridge. When plans are drafted, they will work with us to determine best access with least impact on residents. Begonia Brothers removed fallen tree limbs along 8-mile Wayne County upgraded 8-mile sidewalk ramps to comply with Americans With Disabilities Act and tapered and re-sodded grass along those ramps. Sunrize Irrigation winterized 8 & 9 Mile wells, Rid-O-Rust pumps, and irrigation system Begonia Brothers completed seasonal mowing; Scotts Lawn Service completed seasonal fertilization rounds Begonia Brothers wrapped holiday lighting on 8 & 9 Mile crabtrees Repaired new Chase Drive mailbox damaged by possible vehicle strike or vandalism.
