7:30	MAINTENANCE NORMAL (Art)	 Begonia Brothers installed annual flowers at both entrances. They repaired 8-mile planting twice: once because of the deer, once because of the vehicle collision noted below. Begonia Brothers removed what turned out to be fallen CFHA common ground branches accumulated by Dukesbury resident following windstorm On June 20, 2014, a vehicle driven by one of our residents ran over the 8-Mile Entryway endcap, destroyed the southernmost light pole, exposed the electrical wires, damaged the flowerbed and newly planted flowers. Art installed caution tape. Waug Electric did emergency disconnect and secured the exposed wires. Begonia Brothers repaired bed and replaced flowers. Dan Wright evaluated the damaged light pole for repairs. Nothing was salvageable. Larry and Art have accelerated their light pole renovation project to locate possible replacement. The driver has been identified. We are summarizing costs for reimbursement. (Cost items currently include: Waug disconnect and re-connect, Dan Wright removal & installation, New pole and lamps, Begonia bed & flower restoration) To date: \$1,426.21 reimbursed to CFHA by resident who drove over Trent/Chase mailboxes & stop sign; \$430 invoiced for Picadilly Circle residents' mailbox damage remains unpaid; existing dues lien continues. Sunrize Irrigation applied Rid-O-Rust cleaner to remove major rust stains. They also reset the Rid-O-Rust timers following an apparent power outage that prevented Rid-O-Rust running for several days of irrigation. We and Sunrize now experimenting with DTE Energy App to monitor for power outages in future. Waug Electric replaced 2 bulbs and 1 ballast on entryway light poles At our request, City Forestry Department removed approximately 7 dead trees along sub streets.
